Tire Recycling Requirements No tires with rims/wheels. Residential tires only. No truck/business tires. Tires must be reasonably clean of dirt. Only 9 tires per vehicle. Please call to make arrangements for tires with rims or loads of more than 9 tires: 1-877-713-2784.



Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off Requirements No appointment required.

HHW items include: paint

household cleaners, pool/auto/lawn chemicals, aerosols, and lighter fluid. Do not transport over 15 gallons or 125 pounds at one time. No containers larger than 5-gallon buckets. Limit 5 televisions or computer monitors per car. NO: Business waste, ammunition, medications, explosive or radioactive materials.

Appliance and Metals Requirements

Residents must call 1-877-713-2784 to receive a confirmation number prior to the event. Space is limited. The following items will be accepted for free: Scrap metals, ovens/ stoves, washers, dryers, air conditioners, water heaters, dish washers, and non-working refrigerators and freezers. For working refrigerators and freezers call 800-599-5792 to arrange for free pickup and a rebate through ARCA an SDG&E program.
