(U) JRIC Notification Regarding: Ex-LAPD Officer Wanted in Homicides, Attacks on Police

- (U) Former Los Angeles PD (LAPD) officer Christopher Jordan Dorner is suspected in the shooting deaths of two people in Irvine on 3 February, and one Riverside PD officer on 7 February. He is also believed to have shot and wounded an LAPD officer and a second Riverside police officer. Dorner has reportedly stated his intention to kill LAPD members and their families in retaliation for his termination from employment.
- (U) Dorner is also suspected of tying up an 81-year-old man and attempting to steal his boat at the Southwestern Yacht Club in San Diego on 6 February. Dorner fled the area when he was unable to start the engine.
- (U) Dorner, has experience as a US Navy reservist, and received training in the use of small arms, including rifles. He is described as a male black, 33-years-old, 6 feet tall, 270 pounds. No current vehicle description is known; his truck was discovered burned near Big Bear on 7 February.

Dorner is considered armed and extremely dangerous. Call 911 if spotted. Do not engage him if encountered.
