

# Postgame Football Notes – Fresno State at San Diego State Saturday, Oct. 21, 2017 – SDCCU Stadium – San Diego, Calif.

#### <u>Big Notes</u>

• SDSU had its 12-game winning streak against Pacific Time Zone teams snapped (was the third-longest active streak in FBS).

**Final Edition** 

- San Diego State had its 12-game winning streak against Mountain West, West Division teams snapped. The Aztecs are now 20-4 in their last 24 contests against the West Division.
- The Aztecs dropped to 8-2 in their last 10 games, 14-4 in their last 18 games and 27-5 in their last 32 contests.
- San Diego State fell to 22-5 in its last 27 home games.
- SDSU has dropped consecutive home games for the first time since the first two of the 2013 season.
- The Aztecs has their three-game winning streak in Homecoming games snapped.
- SDSU dropped to 12-3 in its last 15 games played in the month of October.

#### <u>Team Notes</u>

- SDSU has now gone 34 straight games with one interception or fewer (dates back to Sept. 12, 2015 at California).
- San Diego State's six turnovers this year have led to seven points for the opponents. The opponent's 12 turnovers have led to 34 points for SDSU.

#### <u>Trends</u>

- SDSU started with the ball for the 69<sup>th</sup> time over the last 79 games.
- San Diego State won the coin toss for the 27th time over the last 48 games.
- The Aztecs have now gone 139 games without suffering a shutout (Nov. 18, 2006 at TCU), which is the third-longest streak among current Mountain West schools (Air Force at 306 and Boise State at 258).
- SDSU held an opponent scoreless on its opening drive for the 26<sup>th</sup> time over the last 33 games and 27<sup>th</sup> time since 2015 (36 games).

#### **Player Notes**

- \* Rashaad Penny, Sr., RB/KR (15 att., 69 yds. | 1 rec., 9 yds. | 4 KR, 57 yds.)
  - Rushed 15 times for 69 yards and had four kick returns for 57 yards.
  - Led the team with 69 rushing yards.
  - Is still ranked ninth all-time at SDSU with 2,523 rushing yards.

#### \* Christian Chapman, Jr., QB (10-for-20, 77 yds., 0 INT)

• Was 10 for 20 passing for 77 yards and did not throw an interception.

- Dropped to 19-5 as the starting quarterback over his career.
- Recorded his seventh straight game without interception and now has thrown 157 passes without throwing an interception (seven touchdowns over that span).

### \* Ronley Lakalaka, Jr., LB (10 tackles)

- Matched his season high with 10 tackles, a feat he also accomplished at Air Force.
- Recorded his third career double-digit tackle game and second this season.

# \* Sergio Phillips, Sr., DT (6 tackles)

- Finished with six tackles, one shy of his season high.
- His six tackles were more than his last two games combined when he had four total.

# **Other Notes**

- QB Christian Chapman started for the 24<sup>th</sup> consecutive game, the longest streak on the team (offense/defense).
- RB/KR Rashaad Penny played in his 49<sup>th</sup> straight game, the longest streak on the team.
- LB Ryan Dunn made his first start of the season and 21<sup>st</sup> of his career. The Aztecs had started the same 11 on defense each of the first seven games of the year (Dunn replaced LB Troy Cassidy).
- Tonight's game temperature was 68 degrees.
- Tonight's attendance was 43,243.
- Tonight's Aztec Honor Warrior was Jimmy Raye (1988-90).
