Dear President Menghini and Chief Van Bibber:

The County of San Diego (County) expects dissolution of the Julian-Cuyamaca Fire Protection District (JCFPD) to occur on April 8, upon the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) recording the Certificate of Completion. County Fire Authority intends to assume responsibility for fire protection and emergency medical services in Julian and Cuyamaca immediately upon dissolution.

To ensure an orderly transition, we ask that you complete the following by <u>9 a.m. on April 8</u>:

- 1. Provide the County with a list of current volunteer/reserve personnel and provide all personnel with the attached information on becoming a County Reserve Firefighter. The application period for JCFPD Volunteers will be open from April 1, 2019 to April 15, 2019. We are prepared to expedite the transition of these personnel to the County in accordance with the LAFCO Resolution terms and conditions.
- 2. Provide a point of contact for the Julian Explorer Program.
- 3. Provide documentation of payment of all employees' wages and leave accrual in full
- 4. Ensure all vehicles and their keys are physically located at Julian-Cuyamaca Fire District Station 56 or 57.
- 5. Provide a list of (1) all current budget account fund balances, (2) all bank accounts and any other appropriations and, (3) all utility accounts and/or other accounts payable. In addition, identify a point of contact for the transition of financial resources to the County.

6. Prepare a check for "County of San Diego" with all JCFPD funds remaining as of April 8.
