Big Notes

- The Aztecs win their 14th straight home game and have won 45 of their last 47 home games (45-2), 63 of their last 68 (63-5) and 72 of their last 78 (72-6).
- SDSU improves to 47-5 (.904) in their last 52 Mountain West home games and 27-2 (.931) in their last 29 MW home contests.
- San Diego State beats UNLV for the sixth straight time and has now won 11 of the last 12 (11-1) in the series and 22 of the last 24 (22-2) since Jan. 18, 2014.
- SDSU's last five victories have been by double-digits (the two previous San Diego State wins were by one point apiece), the Aztecs' longest streak of double-digit wins inside a winning streak since a nine-game stretch from Jan. 22-Feb. 25, 2021 (SDSU won 12 straight games overall from Jan. 22-Nov. 9, 2021).
- The Aztecs did not trail in the game for the third time this season (first time since Nov. 14 against Long Beach State) and led for 39 minutes, 11 seconds (39:11) of the game.
- F Jaedon LeDee recorded his seventh double-double of the season with 20 points and 11 rebounds. <u>LeDee now has two of SDSU's three games with at least 20 points, 10 rebounds and 3 steals in the last 10-plus seasons (since 2013-14) (today and Nov. 14 vs. Long Beach State), joining Jalen McDaniels (Jan. 26, 2019 vs. UNLV).</u>

Team Notes

- SDSU improves to 91-10 under Brian Dutcher at home.
- Under Brian Dutcher, the Aztecs move to 36-14 in games in January and as a program has won 80 of its last 105 (80-25) games in the first month of the year.
- SDSU improves to 251-139 (.644) all-time in Mountain West games, including a 154-44 (.778) mark in home conference games.
- The Aztecs win their 18th straight game when leading at the half. SDSU is 156-8 in its last 164 home games and has won 210 of their last 234 (210-24) when leading at intermission.
- San Diego State wins for the 400th time in the last 414 games (400-14) when leading with five minutes to play. Under Brian Dutcher, when leading with five minutes to go, the Aztecs have won 18 straight and are 147-10 (.936).
- SDSU moves to 109-23 under Brian Dutcher and 235-48 in its last 283 games when outscoring the
 opponent's bench.
- The Aztecs move to 46-20 (.697) on Saturdays under Brian Dutcher and have won their last 12 on the day.
- SDSU is now 105-16 (.868) in its last 121 games under Brian Dutcher wearing its white uniforms.
- The Aztecs won the battle of the boards and moves to 119-12 under Brian Dutcher when they outrebound their opponent.
- San Diego State wins its 20th straight game when outrebounding its opponent.
- The Aztecs have won 71 of their last 74 games when outrebounding their opponent (71-3) and 260 of their last 298 (260-38).
- The Aztecs improve to 133-9 (.936) under Brian Dutcher when shooting better than their opponent.
- SDSU outscored UNLV in the following situations:
 - 10-2 on fast-break opportunities
 - 18-12 off the bench
 - 54-49 from the starting five

Series Notes

- San Diego State improves to 43-37 against UNLV and has won its last six against the Runnin' Rebels.
- SDSU's six-game win streak against UNLV is currently its fifth longest against a Mountain West opponent.
- Head coach Brian Dutcher improves to 11-2 against UNLV, including 5-1 at Steve Fisher Court.
- San Diego State is now 17-7 all-time against UNLV in Mountain West home games with 13 of the 17 wins coming by double digits.
- The Aztecs have now won 11 of the last 12 (11-1) in the series and 22 of the last 24 (22-2) since Jan. 18, 2014.

Game Flow

- UNLV won the tip.
- San Diego State scored the first points a Micah Parrish 3-pointer of the glass at 19:11.
- San Diego State scored the first eight points of the game and held the Rebels with out a score for the 3:06.
- Leading 8-3, SDSU went on a 10-0 run over 3:36 to extend its lead to 18-3.
- San Diego State held UNLV to five points on 2-of-15 shooting through the first 9:51 of the game.

- In the second half, neither team was able to string together more than six straight points.

Player Notes

Jaedon LeDee – 20 points, 8-14 FG, 11 rebounds, 3 steals

Had his seventh double-double of the season (SDSU is 6-1) and ninth of his career... Logged his ninth 20-point game of the season and 12th of his career... Scored in double figures for the 14th time this season in 14 appearances... Now has 33 career double-figure scoring games, 25 of which have come in the 53 games he has played as an Aztec... Led the Aztecs in scoring for the 10th time of the season... Recorded his seventh game of the season with at least 10 rebounds (11th time of his career)... Topped SDSU in rebounding for the 11th time this season and 30th time of his career... Matched a career high with three steals (fourth time)... Now has two of SDSU's three games with at least 20 points, 10 rebounds and 3 steals in the last 10-plus seasons (since 2013-14) (today and Nov. 14 vs. Long Beach State), joining Jalen McDaniels (Jan. 26, 2019 vs. UNLV).

Micah Parrish – 14 points, 5-8 FG, 2 rebounds, 3 steals

Reached double figures for the 10th time in 14 appearances this season and 52nd time in his career... Made multiple three-pointers for the sixth time this season and 40th time of his career... Logged his third game of the season with at least three steals.

Darrion Trammell - 10 points, 2 rebounds, 1 assist, 2 steals

Recorded his fifth double digit scoring game, all in the last seven games and 72nd game in his career... Had multiple steals for the fourth time this season (SDSU is 4-0) and 51st time of his career.

Jay Pal – 7 points, 7-8 FT, 6 rebounds

Scored all seven of his points from the free-throw line... The seven made free throws and eight free-throw attempts were both season highs... Matched a season high with six rebounds (second straight game).
