San Diego State vs. Wyoming Postgame Notes Steve Fisher Court at Viejas Arena | San Diego, Calif. March 4, 2023

Big Notes

- San Diego State extends its record of Mountain West men's basketball championships to 15 (The next closest is New Mexico with eight titles).
- San Diego State wins its record ninth (9) Mountain West regular-season title and its eighth (8) outright regular-season crown.
- San Diego State has won at least 19 games in each of the last 18 seasons and has won at least 24 games in 10 of the last 18 seasons.
- San Diego State is tied for the third-longest active Division I streak of consecutive seasons with at least 19 victories (1. Kansas 40, 2. Gonzaga 26, 3. San Diego State, Belmont 18, list includes this season with all teams on the list having reached at least 19 wins).
- San Diego State is the No.1-seed in next week's Mountain West tournament. It is the seventh time SDSU has been the top seed in
 the conference's tournament and the program has won two MW tournament titles (2006 & 2021) from that position.
- San Diego State is 7-1 in its last eight games overall.
- Head Coach Brian Dutcher has recorded at least 23 wins in each of the last four seasons and in his six seasons of leading the
 program has never coached a team that didn't win at least 21 games.
- SDSU wins the 24th of its last 28 Mountain West games overall (24-4).
- San Diego State improves to 81-25 (.764) in Mountain West games in the Brian Dutcher era, the start of the 2017-18 season, including a 49-6 mark in conference home games in that time frame.
- SDSU improves to 143-46 (.757) under Brian Dutcher.
- For the seventh time this season, San Diego State never trailed in a game.

Team Notes

- The Aztecs move to 130-10 in the Brian Dutcher era when leading with five minutes to play.
- SDSU moves to 15-1 in its last 15 Mountain West home games and is 80-11 since January 8, 2013 when it hosts home league games.
- San Diego State improves to 19-3 this season, 123-16 in the Brian Dutcher era and 186-24 in its last 210 games when it leads
 at the half.
- SDSU improves to 20-2 on the season when outrebounding its opponent and 105-12 under Brian Dutcher.
- San Diego State's nine blocked shots is a season high and the most since the team had 10 against No.12 Gonzaga on Dec. 21, 2017.
- San Diego State improves to 95-44 in its last 139 Saturday games.
- SDSU moves to 7-1 this year, 38-8 in the Brian Dutcher era and 65-21 in its last 86 games in the month of February.
- SDSU's bench outscores the Cowboys, 30-6. San Diego State is now 20-5 on the season and 93-23 under Brian Dutcher when its bench outscores its opponent.
- SDSU outscored Wyoming, 17-11, in second chance points.

Series Notes

- SDSU has won ten (10-0) consecutive games against Wyoming, regardless of location, and is 13-1 in the last 14 games played between the teams.
- San Diego State sweeps the regular-season series for the eighth time in the last 12 seasons in which the teams played two regular season contests (the other four series were split). The last time Wyoming swept a regular-season series was in the 2006-07 campaign.
- San Diego State leads the all-time series, 50-41. In the Mountain West Conference era, the Aztecs own a 32-17 series advantage.
- The Aztecs are now 18-5 all-time against Wyoming at Steve Fisher Court.
- Brian Dutcher improves to 10-1 as a head coach against Wyoming.
- San Diego State improves to 15-0 against Wyoming in Viejas Arena since January 3, 2007.

Game Flow

- San Diego State first score came on the first possession of the game on a layup by Aguek Arop at 19:15 of his own offensive rebound.
- San Diego State held Wyoming scoreless for the first 4:23 limiting the Cowboys to 0-4 on field goals and forcing two turnovers, blocking two shots and picking up two steals.
- San Diego State used a 10-0 run to turn a 9-8 lead into a 19-8 lead (the run covered 4:35 of game time).
- San Diego State's largest lead of the first half was 19 points (34-15, 1:53 mark).
- San Diego State won the tip.

Player Notes

Jaedon LeDee — 21 points, 8-of-9 FGs, 5-of-6 FTs, 8 rebounds, 2 blocks, 1 assist

Scored at least 10 points in a game for the 7th time this season and 15th time of his career... Led the team in scoring for the 4th time in 2022-23 and the 8th time in his career (6-2)... Matched his collegiate best with eight field goals and set a season high with two blocks.

Adam Seiko — 14 points, 5-of-7 FGs, 4-of-5 3FGs, 2 assists, 2 steals

Reached double figures in scoring for the 6th time this season and 15th time in his career... Drained multiple treys for the 12th time this season and 37th time in his career (31-6)... With zero turnovers tonight, he has committed one turnover or less in 10 straight games.

Matt Bradley - 11 points, 4 rebounds, 1 steal

Reached double figures in scoring for the 21st time this season (16-5) and 118th of his career... Extended his streak of scoring a point to 128 straight games... Has also drained at least one three-point field goal in eight consecutive outings.

Micah Parrish – 6 points, 2-of-4 3FGs, 6 rebounds, 2 blocks

Drained multiple treys for the 13th time this season (11-2) and 31st occasion in his career (20-11)... Matched his season best with six rebounds and tied his collegiate high with two blocks.
