Postgame Softball Notes – San Diego State at No. 15 overall seed Utah

Big Notes

- San Diego State lost its first NCAA Super Regional in program history, falling to 1-1.
- The Aztecs had their seven-game winning streak snapped (all in the postseason). SDSU is now 7-1 in the postseason.
- San Diego State had its four-game winning streak snapped in the NCAA tournament.
- The Aztecs fell to 23-7 (.767) over their last 30 games.
- SDSU to 22-25 all-time in the NCAA tournament.

Series Notes

- San Diego State fell to 34-50 all-time against Utah.
- The Aztecs saw their three game winning streak in the series snapped.

Trends

- The Aztecs fell to 12-7 on the season against teams who made the NCAA tournament.
- SDSU fell to 30-7 on the season when only playing one game on the day.

Player Notes

*** Bella Espinoza, So., LF (2-for-3, R)**

Had her team-leading 23rd multi-hit game of the season ... Extended her hitting streak to 10 games, going 18-for-36 (.500) over that span ... Also has multiple hits in seven straight games, posting a .600 average (15-for-25) over the seven games ... Recorded her 73rd and 74th hits of the season, tied for the fifth most in SDSU single-season history ... Also extended her single-season record with her 69th single (her second hit).

*** Dee Dee Hernandez, So., LHP (1.2 IP, 6 H, 4 ER, 0 BB, 0 K)**

Gave up a grand slam, snapping her scoreless inning streak at 21 innings ... Gave up her first run in postseason play (entered the game with a 1-0 record, two saves and a 0.00 ERA in 14 1/3 innings in six postseason appearances).

Other Notes

- First pitch was 3:05 p.m. MT.
- The temperature was 69 degrees at first pitch.
- Today's attendance was 2,925, the most in Dumke Family Softball Stadium history.
- The game was delayed for 43 minutes because of lightning with two outs in the top of the third inning.
