Thank you for contacting me concerning the spending debate in Congress. I appreciate the opportunity to respond to you on this important matter.

As you know, H.R. 2775, the 2014 Continuing Appropriations Act, extends government funding through January 15, and suspends the debt ceiling through February 7. With a national debt now approaching \$17 trillion—more than \$50,000 for each citizen—we can no longer delay hard choices. My vote against H.R. 2775 was predicated on the fact that the measure fails to address some of the most serious issues facing this nation.

Moving ahead, I look forward to working with my colleagues to reach solutions that will put our nation on the path to fiscal sustainability. These must include serious discussions on entitlement reform, an overhaul of our tax code and targeted spending cuts. As these issues continue to be discussed, I will keep your comments firmly in mind.
