San Diego State Postgame Notes at Colorado State

Notes

- San Diego State has now won five of its last six games (5-1).
- The Aztecs improve to 7-4 in Mountain West Conference play and is now three games above .500 in league play for the first time since finishing the 2015-16 league campaign with a 16-2 record.
- With the victory, the Aztecs pull within one game of second place in the Mountain West (currently shared by Utah State and Fresno State).
- San Diego State and Nevada are the only Mountain West Conference teams that have not lost a league home game and have won at two conference road wins.
- San Diego State is 16-4 in its last 20 games against Mountain West Conference teams.
- The Aztecs win their third straight game against Colorado State and are 21-6 in its last 27 games against the Rams.
- San Diego State is 10-4 in its last 14 visits to Moby Arena. The Aztecs 10 wins are the most by a visiting team in the venue since Feb. 4, 2006. Since that date, SDSU is 10-4 in Moby Arena, while the rest of the teams are a combined 62-137.
- San Diego State has won two games in four days in which the Aztecs were underdogs according to KenPom.
- San Diego State is 7-4 in Mountain West play (the Aztecs were 5-6 in both 2017-18 and 2016-17 after 11 league games).
- San Diego State is 4-4 in its last eight Mountain West Conference road games dating back to last season.
- San Diego State is 7-2 in Tuesday games this season and is 42-11 in its last 53 games played on the day.
- The Aztecs are 62-41 in its last 103 road games.
