Big Notes

- San Diego State wins its fourth straight game and the Aztecs have won nine of its last 10 (9-1).
- San Diego State defeats Nevada for the eighth straight time.
- San Diego State has won 34 straight games when scoring at least 65 points.
- San Diego State has won 31 straight games when shooting 50 percent or better from the field.
- This is the first time in the Brian Dutcher/Steve Fisher era that San Diego State has won consecutive one-point games in back-to-back games.
- Matt Bradley, 24 points and six rebounds, matched his SDSU high with his third straight 20-point game.
- San Diego State's starting backcourt of Trey Pulliam (12 points) and Lamont Butler (11 points) reached double figures in the same game for the
 first time since Nov. 30, 2021 (Long Beach State).
- Keshad Johnson, 10 points, has shot 50 percent or better in 13 of his last 14 games.
- In its final nine regular season games, San Diego State averaged 70.6 points, 47.7 percent field goal shooting, 41.8 percent three-point field goal percentage.

Player Notes

Matt Bradley – 24 points, 6-10 FGs, 11-12 FTs, 6 rebounds

Recorded his third straight 20-point game (tied his San Diego State long streak)... Has 80 points in his last three games (26.7 ppg)... Had a career-high 12 free throws attempted and tied a career-high with 11 free throws made... Has 16 rebounds in his last two games (8.0 rpg)... Recorded his 35th career 20-point game and 12th 20-point effort of the season... This was his 24th double-digit scoring game and 95th career double-digit scoring game... Led SDSU in scoring for the 17th time this season... He became the first Aztec player since Xavier Thames to score at least 24 points while attempting 10 field goals or fewer (Thames did it vs. Creighton, 11-29-13, 26 points, 7-10 FGs).

Trey Pulliam – 12 points, 5-10 FGs, 4 assists, 3 rebounds

Posted his third double-digit game in the last four outings... He has 11 double-digit scoring games this season (9-2) and 19 in his career (17-2)... Has back-to-back games with at least four assists for the first time during the 2021-22 conference campaign... This was the 16th time this season and the 36th time in his career that he has led the Azters in assists

Lamont Butler – 11 points, 4-7 FGs, 2-3 3FGs, 3 rebounds

Had his highest scoring game since an 11-point effort against No. 20 Colorado State (1-8-22)... Had his sixth double-digit scoring game of the season (5-1) and the 11th time in his career (9-2)... Was 2-for-3 from three-point range after going 0-for-8 from bonus distance in his last three games.

Keshad Johnson – 10 points, 4-6 FGs, 6 rebounds, 3 blocked shots

Set a career-high with three blocked shots (the final, coming on the final field goal attempt of the game)... Reached double figures for the fifth time in the last eight games and nine of the last 18 games... He has 10 double-digit scoring games this season (10-0) and 12 times in his career (12-0)... Has shot 50 percent or better from the field in 13 of his last 14 games (61.5 percent).
