Any and all records related to complaints regarding emissions and odors from the Neptune Society crematorium in El Cajon (sometimes incorrectly reported as Lakeside).A TURKO FILES report last night reports the County Air Pollution Control District says your agency now calls this the "Worst case in 20 years."Specially please provide these records:

1. Did you take measurements of specific pollutants in the emissions you found in this investigation? Please provide detailed results. How dangerous are those?
2. What actions are planned now? Will you seek an injunction to close the facility? Have you notified state regulators? Please provide documents of ALL actions taken.
3. How many complaints have you received in the past? (provide copies). What dates and times did you conduct inspections in response to those complaints?
4. Did you provide advance notice to Neptune of those inspections?
5. Who owns the facility? Does it have any ties to Service Corporation International (SCI)?

INSPECTION OF PUBLIC RECORDS

The district shall make a determination if the records requested are available with the exception of those records specifically exempted from disclosure by state law and those records labeled as "TRADE SECRET" which are not emission data, within ten (10) days of the date of the receipt of the request. If, for good cause, the determination cannot be made within the ten (10) working days, the District will notify the requesting person the reasons for the delay and when the determination is expected to be made within an additional 14 days, as prescribed by law. Those records labeled as "TRADE SECRETS" shall be governed by the procedure set forth in District Rule 177 Section (g).
